The New Settled Minister of Los Altos United Church of Christ



The Congregation of LAUCC met on Sunday, September 26, and voted to call the Rev. Kyle Tade as the new Settled Pastor of Los Altos United Church of Christ. Kyle's start date is January 18, 2021. We are excited about this new chapter in our congregational life.

Biography

Rev. Kyle Andrew Tade grew up outside of Chicago. He graduated from Elmhurst University with his Bachelor's in Spanish and Religious Studies and graduated with a Master of Divinity from Duke Divinity School. Kyle was baptized in the United Church of Christ and active in the wider church as a youth when he felt his call to ministry as a teen. He was ordained in the United Church of Christ during his first few months of serving the UCC in Portage, Michigan. Kyle is the youngest of 4 boys who live across 4 states and three time zones. He loves experimenting in the kitchen, travel, reads Green Lantern, and he can find peace anywhere there's sand and a body of water. Over the past three years, Kyle has developed and cultivated a spiritual practice of painting icons; he loves cooking, travel, and Green Lantern comics. He has served as an associate pastor at the Portage UCC in Michigan for the last seven years where he lives with his partner Ken.

I am passionate about... *"I am passionate about the spiritual and emotional journeys we walk. I find great joy in helping others discover how the Bible can become a real, lived experience. I love working through the texts, reading and studying, seeking ways that connect our ancient scriptures not only to today but finding the places where we realize the text matters in the present moment. I am passionate about exploring, experiencing, finding, and sharing new, different and unexpected places we can meet Christ."*

Reflect on your personal and professional formation for ministry. *"The Mark - Engaging in sacred stories and traditions. I am a huge proponent of faith formation across ages and committed to seek ways that communicate and encourage dialogue around similar topics across generations. Confirmation has been one such place. Over the years I have added new components to the confirmation program; placing greater emphasis on our sacred texts the first half of the year and then to engage our faith critically through topical studies such as:*

death and resurrection, justice, God and science and how this influences our understanding of God, the world and ourselves.”

“Much like the disciples who gather around the table in fellowship and in learning, the table is a place where they meet Christ; so too has the table become a place where we all meet and engage with one another, but also with Christ.”
